DIRECTIONS CREDIT UNION ANNOUNCED SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS

Sylvania, Ohio - Directions Credit Union (DCU) has announced the winners of their annual Directions Scholarship Program. Two \$1000 one-year Secondary Scholarships are awarded to students for private high school tuition in grades 9th through 12th for the 2011-2012 school year and two \$1000 Post-Secondary one-year scholarships are awarded to full-time students attending an accredited college, community college, vocational/trade schools in the 2011-2012 school year.

The \$1000 Secondary Scholarship recipients are Nicholas Carroll of St. John Jesuit High School in Toledo, OH and Jacob Szymanski of Central Catholic High School in Toledo, OH. The \$1000 Post-Secondary Scholarship recipients are Andrew Garn who will be attending Ashland University in Ashland, OH and Timothy Schloz who will be attending the University of Toledo in Toledo, OH.

Scholarships are awarded to the students who receive the highest score on their application. The criterion includes the applicant's academic achievements, demonstration of school and/or community performance and the quality of a completed essay.
